Scheduling your Purim Seudah. This year Purim is Thursday night/Friday 13-14 March. Most years, Seudat Purim is after Mincha. However, this year, it is highly preferable to start your Seuda (excluding 'walled' cities, see below) Friday before noon. This allows you to recover your appetite by Shabbat (see Rema, OH 695:2 and Mishna Berura sec. 10; though other options are known). Most authorities concur that as a holiday meal, your

Purim Seuda should include bread, wine and meat. Al ha-Nissim is added to the Birkat ha-Mazon, but the latter is not repeated if the addition is omitted. Mincha on Friday (17:36 at Berman) is recited just before Kabbalat Shabbat and Al ha-Nissim is recited (Amida is not repeated if omitted).

[When the 14th of Adar falls on Friday, Shushan Purim in walled cities like Jerusalem, falls on Shabbat. This creates an anomalous situation referred to as "Purim Meshulash," where Megilla reading and Matanot la-Evyonim is carried out on Friday, Al ha-Nissim is recited in Davening and Birkat ha-Mazon on Shabbat, and the Purim Seuda and Mishloah Manot are fulfilled on Sunday.]

Lecture by Ofra Lax, Journalist and mother of fallen soldier First Lieutenant Naveh Lax HY"D, Monday, 17 March 2025, 20:00, Maariv 19:45. The lecture will be given in easy Hebrew and is entitled: במקום שבו צריך. On Simchat Torah 2023, Israel was stormed by an Amalek-like enemy. Young Israeli soldiers rushed from their homes willing to do anything to stop the massacre. Many sacrificed their lives. Among them was 21-year-old Naveh Lax HY"D, grandson of Ellen and Mel Lax who have been Berman members for almost 50 years. We are deeply honored that Naveh's mother Ofra has agreed to come to Bermans to speak of acts of bravery and devotion to others that took place during that time. Ofra will also be selling her book entitled "במקום שבו צריך אותי" after the lecture.


